Class descriptions

Puddle Jumpers 2' Open to all riders and horses or ponies. .65 meters (2'1.")

Puddle Jumpers .65m (2'1") Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing.

Novice Jumpers .80m (2'7") -Open to children and adult amateurs in their first or second year of showing in the jumpers at .80m (2'7") or higher as of December first of the current year.

Loudoun Prep Jumper .90m (2'11") -Open to horses or ponies. This is a great prep class for Loudoun Benefit Show on the Upperville Grounds second week of June.

Low Jumpers 1m (3'3") - Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders (Exceptions: See Novice Jumper and Novice Child/Adult Jumper) Fence Height 3'

Upperville Prep Jumpers 1.10m (3'7") -Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions. This is a great prep class for the Upperville Horse show, first week of June. (Upperville Horse Show is the oldest horse show in the U.S.A. www.Upperville.com)

O'Meara Jumpers 1.10m (3'7") -Open to horse and ponies. No restrictions.

Named in honor of brothers Frank O'Meara (1945-2019) and Ben O'Meara (1939-1966). Amazing horseman who had a passion for horses and who loved this farm. We will miss Frank's visit, encouragement and excitement of our progress over the last 19 years. Please Note: IF YOU ENTER AN IRISH BRED HORSE in this Class, you will be eligible for a special prize! TABLE MEANINGS

Table II, Sec. 1 The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clean rounds or equal faults will be classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

Table II, Sec. 2 (b) The first round and jump off if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If the competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump off course. Anyone leaving the ring before the jump-off will be considered to have retired.

45 Second Rule: Riders have 45 seconds from audible signal to cross the start line, in any round.

Show Fees & Rules

Fees:

- \$20.00 per class for Jumper Show
- EMT/Office fee: \$25.00 for all entries
- Stall fee: \$25 per show. We have several stalls, but they are in high demand. Reservations are highly recommended.
- Convenience fees for Credit Cards
- Returned check fee: \$50.00
- *Tickets for Equestrian Festival are separate fee and can be pre-purchased on our website: www.TheMiddleburgBarn.com or purchased at the gate on Festival Day, if horse show competitors wish to stay.*

Fox Chase Farm Show Rules and Regulations

1. Fox Chase Farm will be hosting as part of the Equestrian Festival on June 1, 2019. Tickets can be purchased for activities on the farm that day for activities such as live music, wine and beer tasting etc.
2. All checks should be made out to "Equestrian Sports LLC"
3. All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while mounted.
4. No Dogs Allowed
5. At every show, an Entry Form must be carefully read and signed by each rider/exhibitor (and his or her parent or legal guardian if under the age of 18) and other related Participants prior to participating in any activity or riding on Fox Chase Farm property.
6. Current negative coggins on all horses on the show grounds must be presented to show secretary.
7. Payment must be left with show secretary in office before numbers are given out.
8. Show Management reserves the right to refuse entries before or during the show without liability or compensation.
9. Show Management will not tolerate hostile or unsportsmanlike behavior. Show Management and Judge's decisions are final.
10. Fox Chase Farm is a private property open to the public for events. Anyone may be asked to leave, at any time, for any reason.
11. Fox Chase Farm, its members, managers, employees, agents, sponsors and affiliates, etc., are not responsible for damaged vehicles or other property and/or any lost or damaged items in vehicles or on the show grounds.
12. Items left on show grounds will be kept for a limited time before given away or thrown out. Please be sure to get all personal items before leaving shows.
13. All riders/exhibitors (including parents and legal guardians if under the age of 18), owners, trainers, their agents and other related Participants will be held responsible for any damage to the Show grounds, jumps, rails/poles, and/or Fox Chase Farm or its affiliates' property.
14. All classes can be moved, canceled, split or combined at the option of Show Management.
15. Judges listed in any program, website, email or anywhere, etc., is not a guarantee that they will be judge on said show days.
16. If any divisions or classes are combined, prize money will not be doubled. Anyone disqualified may be found ineligible for ribbons, prizes or prize money.
17. Ribbons or prizes must be picked up at show office on show days or during the regular business farm hours, or by scheduling an appointment.
